

HAVING OPEN ARTS EXHIBITION 2018

To all Havering artists



Havering Arts Council is pleased again to be organizing an art exhibition presenting works of the enormous range of talented artists working locally. This will be held in the café area of the Queen's Theatre, Billet Lane, Hornchurch RM11 1QT, from Tuesday 21st August to Sunday 3rd September.

There will be awards for the the Havering Over-60s' prize, an award for those aged 18 - 25 and/or in full-time education, a Best in Exhibition award open to all entrants, and a People's Award voted for by the public. But really it is the taking part and sharing your art with the local community that is the main thing.

To be eligible to enter you need to: live in Havering; or work in Havering; or belong to a recognized art group which meets in Havering.

Please note that there is a limit of 2 works for each individual artist, and these should not have been exhibited previously in the Havering Open Art Exhibition. There is an entrance fee of £5 per work (cheque or cash to Havering Arts Council), but the first work for each artist is free of charge for those who belong to a Havering Arts Council member group, or who are individual HAC members. (Membership starts at £5 for both individuals and groups, and membership fees for 2018/19 must have been received by the start of the exhibition.) The first work is also free for those in full-time education.

You may sell your works, in which case they should be collected by the purchaser rather than the artist. Sales will be made through Havering Arts Council, and commission of 18% (inclusive of VAT) will be added to all sales by Queen's Theatre. Havering Arts

Council and the Queen's Theatre are not liable for any loss or damage to exhibits howsoever caused. Artists are advised to take out their own insurance cover if they so wish.

The exhibition is for paintings, drawings, prints (not reproductions), photography, collage, computer art, embroidery, tapestry, calligraphy, marquetry, reliefs, and wall-hanging three-dimensional work in all media. All works must be framed (which includes box-framed canvas). The Queen's Theatre's new display arrangements means that in most cases works can be hung using your existing wires, hooks, etc. Exceptionally (particularly with larger/heavier items), it may be necessary to fix additional hanging materials to the rear of the frame. Please state at the time of submission if you do not give your permission for us to do this.

Works are accepted for entry into the exhibition at the discretion of Havering Arts Council. Awards are made by decision of the panel of judges, who will not enter into correspondence with entrants.

All works and completed entry forms must be delivered to: Fairkytes Arts Centre, 51 Billet Lane, Hornchurch RM11 1AX, between 10am and 1pm on Sunday 19th August. You will be given a copy of your entry form, and you will need to present this and collect your exhibits on Sunday 9th September, again between 10am and 1pm.

Please note that, although we will be using Fairkytes Arts Centre for administrative purposes, the Havering Arts Council is not Fairkytes, and they are not us – so please don't bother their staff with questions about the exhibition, address them to me!

I hope you will enter the exhibition, and good luck!
